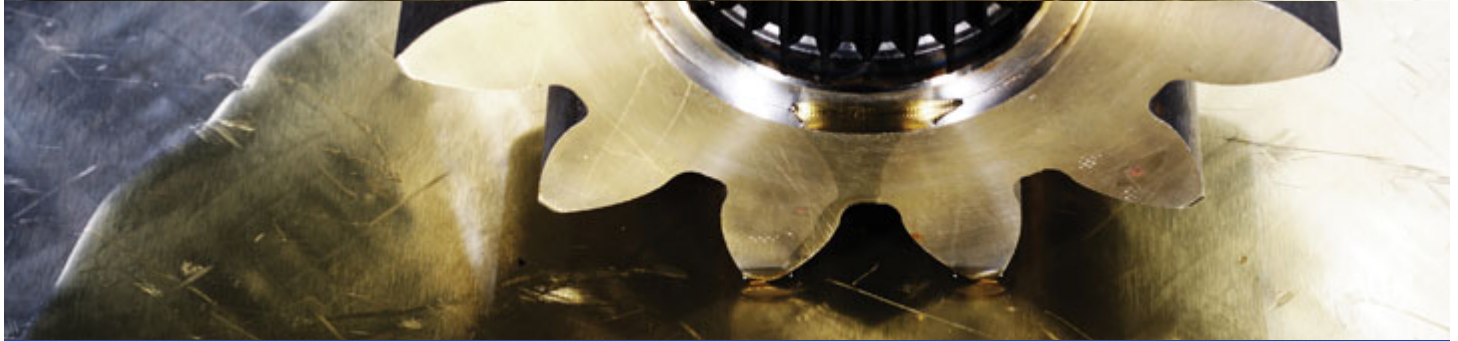

Serial Failures Reduced By Lubrication Survey

Increasing reliability and lowering costs

ISSUE

Lubrication regimes on-site at a large cereal manufacturer had suffered with the scaling back of an on-site dedicated contractor.

Failures attributed to inadequate lubrication were increasing and reliability of equipment was suffering.

SOLUTION

ERIKS were able to offer a solution which would identify all points of lubrication, site wide, and create a comprehensive database.

Each lubrication point would be physically marked up with the type, quantity and frequency of lubrication required and loaded into the customer's planned maintenance systems.

Lubrication stations would be offered in strategic locations for ease of use. Rationalisation of all lubricants would avoid cross contamination of lubricant types, streamlining of brands, saving the customer money and reducing stock holding.

The customer has now proceeded with a systematic approach to surveying the plant to maintain reliability.
